EXPAND YOUR KNOWLEDGE BASE

Licensed teachers aiming to improve their instructional skills get their start here.

Roosevelt's advanced educator programs provide innovative professional development for teachers who want to make a greater impact on their students' learning. Our programs focus on improving reading and literacy instruction, meeting the needs of bilingual and ESL students, and supporting learners with special needs. Degree programs are offered entirely online and in hybrid formats, which incorporate face-to-face study during the summer months. Upon completion of each program, licensed teachers are eligible to add one or more endorsements to their Illinois teaching licenses.

Roosevelt also provides licensed teachers opportunities to earn endorsements without enrolling in a degree program. Non-degree students can enroll in up to six courses (18 credit hours) without declaring a major, while benefiting from the same high-quality instruction provided to degree-seeking students.

Counseling students are specially trained for trauma and diversity and complete intensive internships at local schools and community agencies. They apply their knowledge gained in the classroom to the real world and thereby better their communities.

Our nationally accredited programs are designed for full- and part-time students and satisfy academic requirements for licensure as a clinical mental health counselor or school counselor. Content courses are integrated to facilitate innovative teaching and learning. Completion leads to Illinois teaching credentials.
